Year 11 English Intervention Class Period 7

We are writing to let you know that your child has been identified as a student who would benefit from additional support in English as they work towards securing a strong GCSE grade in English Language.

English is a vital qualification for students' future education, training and employment opportunities. A strong pass in GCSE English Language is an important requirement for many post-16 courses, apprenticeships and future career pathways. We want to make sure that every Year 11 student has the best possible opportunity to achieve their potential.

To provide additional support at this important stage of Year 11, your child will be required to attend a compulsory English intervention session every **Wednesday Period 7 in Room WS02**.
